The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) has announced publication of the regulations providing care for Camp Lejeune Veterans and reimbursement for care for their family members potentially affected by chemically tainted drinking water at U.S. Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. You are receiving this letter after indicating an interest in the matter.

On August 6, 2012, President Obama signed into law the "Honoring America's Veterans and Caring for Camp Lejeune Families Act of 2012." Since this law was passed, VA has been providing health care to Veterans who served on active duty at Camp Lejeune for at least 30 days between August 1, 1953, and December 31, 1987. We are pleased to inform you that regulations were recently published that now allow VA to provide qualified Camp Lejeune **family members** reimbursement for health care costs related **only to the 15 medical conditions listed in the law** (*bladder cancer, breast cancer, esophageal cancer, female infertility, hepatic steatosis, kidney cancer, leukemia, lung cancer, miscarriage, multiple myeloma, myelodysplastic syndromes, neurobehavioral effects, non-Hodgkin's lymphoma, renal toxicity, and scleroderma*).

For Family Members of Veterans: The Camp Lejeune Family Member Program (CLFMP) is active and you may submit an application for health benefits by applying online at <https://www.clfamilymembers.fsc.va.gov>. Submitted applications and supporting documentation will be reviewed to determine family member eligibility for the program.
