Relationship with Frederick Scottish Pipes and Drums

The Frederick Pipes and Drums have a long history of partnering/supporting SASMM events however it is not clear what that really means and entails. There are some events that SASMM pays for the pipes and drums and others that we do not and the piper and drums are volunteers

Information from 2015 (and some past) SASMM events that the pipes and drums have supported: V= volunteer (no donation) D = Donation

- 1. Burns Supper: V however there is no charge for dinner (about \$25 dollar value).
- 2. Spring Kirkin: V
- 3. Festival: D (\$500.00) In 2013, 2014, and 2015 there was also a Friday night banquet. Was this included in the \$500 or not? Note: There will not be a banquet in 2016, but instead an Open House at the festival grounds.
- 4. Celtic Night at the Keys: V (admission ticket provided for them and family)
- 5. Fall Kirkin: V
- 6. Hogmanay: V (one year in the past there was a donation jar). As agreed, the pipers will have a donation jar this year (2015)
- 7. Other events: I understand that SASMM makes arrangements for pipers for events (e.g. funeral, wedding, etc.) for members in good standing (From the Bylaws). Not sure who pays for that service; SASMM, the family, or there is no pay. See Meeting minutes for clarification.

Thoughts: Determine payment event by event; a donation for the year that covers an agreed upon number of events, etc. See meeting minutes for decision.

Relationship with Frederick Scottish Country Dancers

The Frederick Scottish Country Dancers also have a long history of partnering/supporting SASMM events however it is not clear what that really means and entails. There are some events that SASMM pays for the dancers and other where there are different arrangements.

- 1. Burns Supper: D (\$50) Demo team (only the demo team and not all dancers) has reduced dinner rate (\$20); they bring sodas
- -- There is question of whether they were paid in 2012, 2013, and 2014. Confirmed they were not. They make the program covers.
 - 2. Festival: D (\$100.00)
 - 3. Hogmanay: V SASMM and FSCD spilt the admission fee 50/50
 - 4. Cards: Send Christmas cards, and other cards as appropriate (not sure of costs)

They also make and sell cards at various SASMM events.

--- Also concern about the banking arrangement with FSCD (not discussed; rescheulde.
